-  Breast Cancer is the most common form of cancer amongst women in Northern Ireland.
-  Whilst normally more prevalent in older women, the disease is increasing in women under 40.
-  EARLY DETECTION COULD SAVE YOUR LIFE

Think 'Pink' – Don't forget

-  Know your breasts well, look and feel for any changes.
-  Report to your GP immediately should you notice anything different, such as a lump, changes in size or shape, persistent pain in your breast or armpit, a rash or discharge from the nipple.
-  9 out of 10 lumps are benign but every lump should be checked by your GP. Finding cancer early will give you better treatment options, could avoid surgery and will give you a better chance of recovery or cure.
